Some of the topics included in this class explore currency, education, health, transport, leisure, law and community and employment.

Taught on-campus for five months, you can study at your own pace with the assistance of knowledgeable teachers, one-on-one tutoring and 10 hours of class time each week. You can enrol at any point throughout the year and start mastering your advanced English skills.

When you finish this course, you will have the advanced skills to be able to seek out work in the community and become a valuable member of any team.
