That's why all apprentices attend 10 x three day blocks per year (Year 1, Year 2, Year 3) for the duration of their apprenticeship. These learning days are designed to make sure your skills are where they should be, and our teachers will be here to support you through that every step of the way.

And because you work and learn at the same time, you can start working in your chosen industry sooner – sounds pretty good to us!

You'll also have the option to take your skills even further, but studying a Certificate IV in Building and Construction, or a Diploma of Building and Construction (not offered at TAFE Gippsland). These qualifications will allow to be advance your career by becoming a builder, increasing your employment opportunities.

## Entry Requirements

### Mandatory entry requirements

- To be enrolled into Certificate III Carpentry and Joinery each student must have a current employer at the time of enrolment due to this course being for apprentices only. Each Apprentice will also be signed by an apprenticeship Centre of choosing by the Employer and have a training contract that states the relationship between the Employer, apprentice and RTO. Once the training contract has been released a Apprentice sign up and Induction is completed within 5 working days and the apprentice commences in class once the enrolment has been confirmed.

### Recommended entry requirements

- Students are required to have a passion for the Industry and are required to be looking for a career as a Carpenter and Joiner.

### Limitations to entry

- Must have a current employer at the time of enrolment due to being an apprenticeship course.
